<p><b>Shoes</b> Plain black leather lace up shoes that can be polished NB: sports shoes or skate shoes are not permitted</p> <p><b>Sandals</b> Plain black sandals with heel strap</p>	<p><b>Physical Education Uniform</b> Reversible BIS PE and house shirt Navy blue shorts with BIS logo</p>	<p><b>Shoes</b> Black low heeled polishable shoes with either laces or a single strap, eg Mary-Jane style shoes (must be worn with school socks or navy or black tights) NB: ballet pump style shoes, sports shoes or skate shoes are not permitted</p> <p><b>Sandals</b> Plain black sandals with low heel and strap, eg roman sandals (no socks or tights to be worn with sandals)</p>
<p><b>Socks</b> Short or long school socks with blue and red stripe NB: Socks are to be worn with school shoes, NOT sandals</p>	<p><b>Optional</b> Winter jacket – navy blue hooded jacket with zip, with BIS logo Hoodie – navy blue hooded sweatshirt with BIS logo Scarf – navy blue scarf with BIS logo</p>	<p><b>Socks /Tights</b> Short or long school socks with blue and red stripe Navy blue or black tights maybe worn NB: Socks or tights are to be worn with school shoes NOT sandals</p>

**Uniform regulations**

- Belmont Intermediate School uniform must be worn to and from school and for all school functions
- Items that are not part of the school uniform may not be worn. Undergarments must not be visible
- Long socks must be worn pulled up
- The sports uniform is to be worn for all physical education lessons and sports events
- Uniforms must be neat and tidy at all times. All items should be clearly named
- A high-visibility vest must be worn when riding a bicycle to and from school
- For safety reasons, only the following jewellery may be worn:
  - a wristwatch
  - single set of gold or silver plain studs for pierced ears - no markings, stones or engraving

- The school cap or bucket hat must be worn for all outdoor activities in terms 1 and 4
- Lipstick and eye makeup are not permitted
- Nail polish is permitted as long as it is a transparent (clear). Nude colours are also permitted (excluding white). Nails must be kept short and neat. Acrylic/ false nails are not permitted.
- Hair must be well groomed and tidy, hair ties and hair adornments are only permitted in navy blue or black
- Only hair colours in the natural human hair range are acceptable. Purple, orange, lime green, pink etc. are not permitted
- Un-natural coloured hair extensions or any hair extensions/ beading/ extension braids of any kind are not permitted
- In the interest of safety or hygiene, any teacher has the right to request hair is tied back, or jewellery removed
- In all Science and Technology rooms, students will wear the approved plain black leather lace up shoes (no sandals)

### To buy the uniform items in person at the uniform shop:

Please visit the uniform shop during the hours listed below. Note that payment is via EFTPOS only (sorry no credit cards). If you are unable to come during these hours, you can order using our [Online Shop](#) or make an appointment with Wendy Riley on 09 489 4878 (ext 128) or [resource@belmontint.school.nz](mailto:resource@belmontint.school.nz).

### Steps for ordering using the Online Shop:

1. Your child (with or without parent/caregiver) will need to go to the uniform shop (old tuck shop, next to Room 4) to select the correct size (see shop opening hours below).
2. Order and pay for your child's reversible PE/house shirt (Brett, Cuvier, Tiri or Pencarrow), PE shorts and school hat using the school's [Online Shop](#). The hoodie and scarf, which are optional uniform items, can also be ordered and paid for on the online shop. Year 7 students will be notified of their house when they are informed of their classroom placement in December and can purchase their PE uniform at this time.
3. Once ordered via the online shop, the uniform item(s) will be delivered to your child via their teacher. Otherwise, your child can pick up their uniform item(s) from Wendy Riley in the Resource Room.
4. Exchanges – unworn uniform items with the size tag still attached (for the PE shirt this is on the side of the house shirt) can be exchanged at the uniform shop.
